Eric Jordan Young (SHORT BIO) is an accomplished producer, director, choreographer, entertainer, playwright and songwriter. Through his 30+ years of experience, Young's performance credits have included television (Law & Order: Criminal Intent, Ugly Betty), Broadway (RAGTIME '98 original/'09 revival, CHICAGO, SEUSSICAL, LOOK OF LOVE), off-Broadway (NYSF – Public Theatre, Lincoln Center, Kennedy Center), national tours (CHICAGO, RAGTIME, STARLIGHT EXPRESS, DREAMGIRLS), commercials and workshops (DESSA ROSE, DIRTY ROTTEN SCOUNDRELS, NEVER GONNA DANCE, DISNEY'S ON THE RECORD, LITTLE FISH, TIN PAN ALLEY RAG, KING

OF BOMBAY, DILLINGER, DORIAN, PAMELA'S FIRST MUSICAL, CLOWNTOWN).

Young appeared in several productions on the Las Vegas Strip including Andrew Llyod Webbers' STARLIGHT EXPRESS (Las Vegas Hilton), the Las Vegas Company of ROCK OF AGES at The Venetian and Rio Resorts (Mayor/J'Keith) and his original production of SHAKIN' – VEGAS REMIXED WITH A TWIST at Planet Hollywood Resort and Casino. Young originated the role of Ernie in VEGAS! THE SHOW, and has performed with several symphonies throughout the United States including the Atlanta Symphony, Buffalo Philharmonic and the New York Pops at Carnegie Hall.

In April of 2016, Young had his solo symphonic debut with CELEBRATING SAMMY: THE MUSIC OF SAMMY DAVIS, JR. (Buffalo Philharmonic). His solo album ONCE IN A LIFETIME was produced by EnJoY! Productions Group and his one-man musical SAMMY & ME (Alliance Theatre, MusicalFare Theatre, Hangar Theatre, NBTF) received the ArtVoice and Salt Awards. Young's direction and choreography can be seen on the high seas in Norwegian Cruise Line productions of WHAT THE WORLD NEEDS NOW and THE GREAT AMERICAN SONG FACTORY. Young served as the resident director of BAZ Las Vegas (Palazzo) and performed nightly in COCKTAIL CABARET at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas.

He is currently working with Norwegian Cruise Line as the Associate Director of FOOTLOOSE (Norwegian Joy) and serves as Director & Choreographer for the original productions WHAT THE WORLD NEEDS NOW (Norwegian Star) and THE GREAT AMERICAN SONG FACTORY (Navigator). Eric is proud to be working as Associate Director for Hollywood's newest production on the Sunset Strip, ROCK OF AGES. Young is a proud graduate of Ithaca College. EnJoY!



Eric was the Creative Director for RENEGADES starring Jose Canseco, Jim McMahon and Hall Of Famer Terrell Owens at Caesars Palace and is also the Artistic Director of a soon to be announced theatre company in Sin City. Eric Jordan Young began performing as a child in Buffalo, New York. Singing in church and elementary school choirs, Eric discovered his talent and honed that talent by watching those he admired, most especially mega stars Michael Jackson, Stevie Wonder, Diana Ross and, above all, Sammy Davis, Jr.

"I was drawn to their energy and dynamism. I remember watching all of them, along with the Jackson 5, Carol Burnett and Benny Hill. I was always happy when I saw them and wanted to give other people the same feeling."

Eric was a member of the Buffalo Arts & Music Youth Chorale under the direction of Donald L Hilliard and appeared in many local television, stage and film projects. His professional career started in high school when he performed with the Upstage New York Theatre

Co., appearing in *George M!* (Artpark), *Damn Yankees* (Artpark), and *Olympus On My Mind*. He filmed his first Public Service Announcement for PBS at 13 and was suddenly hooked on show business.

He earned a BFA with honors in Musical Theater, graduating from Ithaca College in 1993. Among the 12 productions in which he appeared at Ithaca are Oedipus at Colonus, The Bacchae, A Chorus Line, Hair, Eastern Standard, John Brown's Body and The Colored Museum. Eric is the proud recipient of Ithaca's 2003 Outstanding Young Alumni Award, presented to graduates who have been recognized as emerging leaders in their fields.

Eric's additional Broadway credits include the 1st National Touring production of *Ragtime* (1998/'99); the Broadway revival of Ragtime ('09), and original casts of *Seussical The Musical* (Wickersham Brother) and *The Look of Love,* the Roundabout Theatre Company's limited-engagement celebration of the music of Burt Bacharach and Hal David.

Keeping busy off-Broadway and in touring companies, Eric Jordan Young, in 2001, received the prestigious Helen Hayes Award as Outstanding Supporting Performer in a Resident Musical for his work in *Side Show*, presented by theatre Washington, the unified organization of theaters in Washington, D.C.

He was in the workshop and, then, Lincoln Center Theater's premiere of *Dessa Rose*, directed by Graciela Daniele, and world premiere of Michael John LaChiusa's *Little Fish* at Second Stage. Eric played the controversial character Zip Coon Crow in the NYSF Public Theatre production of *Neighbors*. Other shows include Gerard Alessandrini's 2001 production of *Mr. President; Ain't Misbehavin'* (Actors Theatre of Louisville); *Smokey Joe's Café* (Sacramento Music Circus); first national tours of *Chicago, Ragtime*, and a national tour of *Dreamgirls*.

Eric moved to Las Vegas for the 1993 production of Andrew Lloyd Webber's all-roller skating show, Starlight Express. He originated the role of King Herod in the World premiere of Jesus Christ Superstar Gospel at Atlanta's Alliance Theatre, played Tom Collins in Rent at the Hangar Theatre in Ithaca, NY; and Booker T. Washington in the Kennedy Center's production of Ragtime.



Eric Jordan Young's work in concerts and tributes includes the world premiere of Altovise Davis' *Mr. Bojangles: The Ultimate Entertainer* as Sammy Davis, Jr.; *Lyrics and Lyricists*, one of a 92nd Street Y series honoring EY ("Yip") Harburg, directed by Ted Sperling; *60th Anniversary Encores! Bash* at City Center; the Ahrens and Flaherty 20th Anniversary Concert at Lincoln Center; the Mabel Mercer Cabaret Convention at Lincoln Center's Rose Hall; *Wall to Wall Sondheim* (Symphony Space) and *The Rat Pack Is Back!* with David Cassidy at The Supper Club, NYC.

He made his Carnegie Hall debut in *Opening Doors*, Stephen Sondheim's 2004 production and says he "was honored" to host Skitch Henderson and the NY Pops Orchestra's 2009 *Young People's Guide To the Orchestra*. He returned to Carnegie Hall for *Once Upon A Time and Tomorrow*, a NY Pops Concert honoring the music of Charles Strouse.

Young has been guest performer with the Arkansas, Atlanta, Louisiana, Sioux City, Ocean City, Reno, Fresno, Evansville and Tucson Symphony Orchestras.

On television, his credits include the pilot of *Ugly Betty, Law and Order: Criminal Intent, Today Show, CBS' Morning Show,* the *Rosie O'Donnell Show, Rachel Ray Show* and several others. He entertained Oprah Winfrey and guests on the *Trip of a Lifetime* cruise which served as a company retreat for her Harpo production staff.

Workshops and readings include Never Gonna Dance (Greif/Mitchell), Pamela's First Musical (Daniele/Colman), Dirty Rotten Scoundrels (O'Brien/Mitchell), Soapdish, Disney's On the Record, Little Fish, Tin Pan Alley Rag, King of Bombay, Dillinger, Dorian, Sacrifice to Eros and more.

Eric Jordan Young has taught jazz dance, musical theater, audition techniques and vocal classes. He was a faculty member of Ann Reinking's Broadway Theatre Project, along with Culver Academy, Ridgefield Dance Academy, Peridance in NYC and other schools. His skating talents were put to use as the skate coach for the Broadway and National Touring productions of the Tony Award winning musical *The Drowsy Chaperone*.

In 2004 Eric conceived and authored Sammy & Me, a one-man musical where he portrays over 30 characters and sings famous songs from the Sammy Davis, Jr. catalogue. Sammy & Me received its World premiere at MusicalFare in his hometown Buffalo, NY and was co-produced with the Hangar Theatre in Ithaca, NY. The show found success at the National Black Theatre Festival in 2007 and was well received in 2010 at the Tony Award winning Alliance Theatre in Atlanta. Sammy & Me has been honored with the Katharine Cornell (Artie) Award and the Syracuse Area Live Theater Award.

This is the tribute that, even if he wasn't aware of it, Eric Jordan Young has been creating since he was a child, when he first saw Sammy Davis, Jr. perform. It follows Davis' career from the chitlin' circuit to the very top of show business. "This project is more than a show about Sammy Davis, Jr. and myself. It is about the heroes we choose to follow throughout our lives. How we honor ourselves by honoring them," says Eric.

Critics have lauded his performances over the years. In *Sammy & Me*, one said he "dazzles." Another said, "Eric Jordan Young...will leave you hoping for a sequel." A third called him "an impressive talent with an irresistibly likable personality."

In 2010, Eric Jordan Young produced his first solo CD *Once In A Lifetime*. A debut for his production company EnJoY! Productions. The collection celebrates the music of Sammy Davis, Jr. and Eric is accompanied by some of the greatest talent in the recording industry.

In the spring of 2014, Eric Jordan Young completed performing nightly in over 2300 performances of *Vegas! The Show* at the Saxe Theater in Las Vegas.

Eric had the incredible opportunity to produce and star in his own show Shakin': Classic Vegas Remixed With A Twist in the fall of 2014. The show played 5 performances a week on the Las Vegas Strip at Planet Hollywood Resort and Casino and received rave reviews. The show brought classic Vegas entertainment to the 2014 season.

Eric is currently the Associate Director of two productions; ROCK OF AGES in Hollywood, CA and the Norwegian Cruise Line production of FOOTLOOSE. Other Norwegian Cruise Line credits include THE LOOK OF LOVE (Creative, Director, Choreography), WHAT THE WORLD NEEDS NOW (Creative, Director, Choreographer) and THE GREAT AMERICAN SONG FACTORY (Director, Choreographer). He toured with THE COCKTAIL CABARET, and was the Resident Director of *BAZ a Musical Mash-Up* at the Palazzo Resort and Casino in Las Vegas. Eric has served as the Creative Director and Production Consultant for several productions in Las Vegas. Eric was the Creative Director for RENEGADES starring Jose Canseco, Jim McMahon and Hall Of Famer Terrell Owens at Caesars Palace and is also the Artistic Director of a soon to be announced theatre company in Sin City. Since the onset of the covid pandemic Eric has worked remotely as a director and continues to build projects including THIS IS CHRISTMAS at the Venetian Resort and Casino. EnJoY!




